Cancellations, Refunds

There will be no refunds 7 business days prior to the start of class or after, unless the individual experiences a medical problem that prohibits participation. Exploration of ideas and friendships with peers are encouraged by our caring Flyers Club staff team. Participation is limited to attending students only. Please note that enrollment options are subject to availability.

Early Release Days

Flyers Club offers after care on days when the elementary schools have half days at no extra cost to students enrolled in after care. Students can attend at their school location from dismissal time until 6 p.m.

Schools Out Camp

Flyers Club offers programming on planned days when Lindbergh Schools is not in session, for an additional fee. Care is not offered when the district closes for inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances. 




