Cancellations, Refunds

There will be no refunds 7-business days prior to the start of class or after, unless the individual experiences a medical problem that prohibits participation for the remainder of the program session. If a medical problem exists, upon presenting a doctor's note, the refund amount will be prorated based on the number of sessions attended, minus any supplies fee. Cancellations prior to 7-business days will receive a refund, minus any supplies fee, however this may not apply to all programs, such as Flyers Club or sports leagues. For Flyers Club or sports leagues, cancellations must be made 14business days prior to the start date. Community Ed & Rec reserves the right to cancel a program, in which case full refunds will be issued. Attendance is the responsibility of program participants and refunds are not available for missing a class. We follow the Lindbergh Schools inclement weather policy.

Financial Assistance

Partial fee assistance may be available for some programs if you are an attending Lindbergh student who qualifies for free/reduced meals through Lindbergh Schools. Fee assistance can only be applied at the time of registration and cannot be retroactive. Some programs may be excluded. Flyers Club Before and After School-Age Care: 2025-26 School Year

Flyers Club provides students of working families in grades K-5 with a fun, safe, and engaging program before and after school. Programs are located at all Lindbergh elementary schools, providing a familiar and convenient setting. Participation is limited to students attending Lindbergh Schools and enrollment options are subject to availability. Our Flyers Club staff plan activities that may include arts and crafts, STEAM, music, reading, and group games.

Enrollment is on a first come, first served basis and is contingent upon available staffing. All enrollment applications are placed on a waiting list pending approval. We have a rolling admissions system based on a staff to student ratio of 1:16. As we continue to confirm staff through the school year, we will move families off the waitlists and into the school year program in the order of registration. You will receive a notification once your contract is approved.

Half Days

Flyers Club offers after care on days when the elementary schools have half days at no extra cost to students enrolled in after care. Students can attend at their school location from dismissal time until 6 p.m. Enrolled families will receive additional information with details prior to those half days.

School's Out Camp

School's Out Camp provides enriching and entertaining programs on planned non-school days, offering a perfect blend of fun and learning! Available for an additional fee, this program is designed to keep kids engaged in a safe and supportive environment. Please note: School's Out Camp is not held on district-recognized holidays, during inclement weather closures, or in the event of unforeseen circumstances. 




